I wish to pay my joining membership fee of £15.00 to Digswell Lake Society (*the Society*) by:

When setting up a standing order, the sum of £15 should be payable as soon as your bank allows, with annual renewals of £10 made on 1 April of each following year.

The initial payment of £15 includes a key deposit of £5 which is repayable on return of the key when you cease to be a member of the Society. Subsequent annual payments of £10 are due on 1 April of every following year. The key will admit you to the lake whenever you please 365 days a year for so long as you remain a member and your annual subscription has been paid.

If you wish to allow the Society to claim Gift Aid on your subscription of £10 and any other donations you make to the Society in the future or have made in the past 4 years, please tick the box below. You confirm you are a UK taxpayer and understand that if you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations in that tax year, it is your responsibility to pay any difference. Please notify us if you (i) want to cancel this declaration (ii) change your name or home address or (iii) no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.
